The school day:

- School will start at **8:50am**.
- **If you drive your child to school, you are being requested to drop them AFTER 8.30am. Buses arrive earlier and we must stagger entry to the school.**

We will be splitting the year groups into smaller classes for induction. We will not be holding full year group assemblies. For the first 2 information sessions students will be 2m apart and then for the last 2 sessions student will be based in well ventilated rooms 1m apart.

Please see the schedule for the 2nd week. It is available in earlier bulletins and on the school website. It is important that we build up numbers in the school incrementally so we can identify any issues as per our risk assessments. The school is operating half days for the first 2 weeks.
