## **Blended Learning/ Online Learning:**

Please note that we are working very hard here in the school to have your child as prepared as possible in the event of a partial or local lockdown, we are currently planning to trial different scenarios e.g. 5<sup>th</sup> years stay at home and log on for some classes etc.

## What does this mean?

- 5. The rest of the lessons will be tasks set by teachers
- 6. Students will give feedback to teachers on Friday

**Period 2**: Gaeilge – This will be a LIVE CLASS

Period 3: English – Teachers will set a TASK via STUDYCLIX

Period 4: Maths – Teachers will set a task for this lesson

**Period 5:** Geog/Ag Science/Art/History – This will be a LIVE CLASS

**Period 6:** History/ Accounting/DCG/PE/German – Teachers will set a task
