### **Blended Learning/ Online Learning:**

6. Students will give feedback to teachers on Friday

**Period 2:** Gaeilge – This will be a LIVE CLASS

**Period 3:** English – Teachers will set a TASK via STUDYCLIX

**Period 4:** Maths – Teachers will set a task for this lesson

**LUNCH**

**Period 5:** Geog/Ag Science/Art/History – This will be a LIVE CLASS

**Period 6:** History/ Accounting/DCG/PE/German – Teachers will set a task

We have been advised by our Management Body that this is one of the best ways to prepare our students and school in the event of another lockdown.
