Blended Learning/ Online Learning:

Please note that we are working very hard here in the school to have your child as prepared as possible in the event of a partial or local lockdown, we are currently planning to trial different scenarios e.g. 6th years stay at home and log on for some classes etc.

I have just spoken with the 6th years and have informed them that as part of our Blended Learning Plan they will 'work from home' on **THURSDAY, October 22nd**

What does this mean?

1. It is NOT a day off
2. Students will follow their normal school timetable
3. Students take breaks as per timetable
4. A maximum of 3 lessons will be live lessons via ZOOM/TEAMS
5. The rest of the lessons will be tasks set by teachers
6. Students will give feedback to teachers on Friday

Period 1: Engineering/Acc/Art/Biology - this will be a **LIVE CLASS**

Period 2: Maths – **Work will be set for this class**

Period 3: DCG/Ag Science/French/German/History– this will be a **LIVE CLASS**

Period 4: Construction/Business/ Chemistry/Music – **Teachers will set a task VIA STUDYCLIX for this lesson – code was emailed to all students today**

LUNCH

Period 5: LCVP/Tutor/LCVP FRENCH – This will be a **STUDY CLASS**

Period 6: English – This will be a **LIVE CLASS**

We have been advised by our Management Body that this is one of the best ways to prepare our students and school in the event of another lockdown.
