Dear Parents / Guardians,

As we come to close to the end of the school year I would like to inform you about end of year details and some other important notices,

Every single member of the RCS school community – staff, students and parents – has to exercise personal responsibility in relation to Covid-19 prevention.

I again urge parents/guardians to limit the contacts of our senior students especially as we get closer to the Leaving Certificate Exams. Please PLEASE avoid 18th birthday parties, graduation parties, end of year parties etc. etc.
