

Ladder of Progression





Language requirements

In general, there are no language requirements for Science, Engineering and Nursing courses.

In Maynooth, no language required for business and law courses also.

Please check websites for entry requirements

 A language may be needed in some of the Health sciences, particularly in UCC and for <u>some</u> medical professional courses, eg. Veterinary medicine, Physiotherapy in UCD



Language requirements

- NUI (Maynooth University, UCC, UCD, NUI Galway and affiliated colleges)
- Irish
- English
- Third language
- Maths is a requirement for some courses

- University of Limerick and affiliated colleges
- Mathematics
- Irish or another language
- English
- Trinity and affiliated colleges
- English
- Maths
- Another language

- DCU and affiliated colleges
- English or Irish
- Maths

- Technological Universities
- English or Irish
- Maths (some exceptions apply)

These requirements are the minimum/basic entry requirements and do NOT include course or faculty requirements so please check websites of individual colleges for specific requirements.

Important Note

- For NUI colleges, if you were not born in Ireland, Irish may be used as your third language.
- If you don't have Irish at all, as a result of where you were born or when you started school in Ireland, you will need a third language (Exceptions DCU and Technological Universities.)
- Trinity require a second language (Irish or any other regardless of exemptions)



Junior Cycle


Percentage	Grade Descriptor
